




TO START:



When you bring the toy home, activate its full range of features by moving the ON/TRY ME/OFF switch to ON.



Press your TUMBLIN' CHUCK toy's light to begin playing. Keep playing with him to see what he does next!



OTHER ACTIVITIES:

BOOMERANG TIME

Roll your TUMBLIN' CHUCK toy backward. He somersaults back toward you.

TURBO TIME

Your TUMBLIN' CHUCK toy revs his engines and shifts into turbo mode.

Move him forward fast to activate!


LOAD-UP TIME

Your TUMBLIN' CHUCK toy will ask you to put something in his bucket. See how much he can hold!

ROLL-ALONG SONG TIME

Your TUMBLIN' CHUCK toy will sometimes hum a song when you roll him. He'll hum faster or slower based on how fast you roll him.

WAYS TO INTERACT WITH TOY:



CHUCK toy works best on hard, flat surfaces.

Sleep Mode: If your TUMBLIN' CHUCK toy is not played with for approximately 45 seconds, he will go to sleep. Press his lights or tickle him to wake him.

NOTE: Activities are random. To change what your TUMBLIN' CHUCK toy is doing, interact with him.

IMPORTANT: BATTERY INFORMATION ••• CAUTION:

1. TO AVOID BATTERY LEAKAGE

- a. Always follow the instructions carefully. Use only batteries specified and be sure to insert them correctly by matching the + and polarity markings.
- b. Do not mix old batteries and new batteries or standard (carbon-zinc) with alkaline batteries.
- c. Remove exhausted or dead batteries from the product.
- d. Remove batteries if product is not to be played with for a long time.
- e. Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- f. RECHARGEABLE BATTERIES: Do not mix these with any other types of batteries. Always remove from the product before recharging. Recharge batteries under adult supervision. DO NOT RECHARGE OTHER TYPES OF BATTERIES.
